OPPORTUNITY KNOCKS ON THE MID-ATLANTIC CORRIDOR



POSITIONED AT THE HEART OF SOME OF NORTH AMERICA'S BUSIEST AIR CORRIDORS, A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY IS EMERGING TO SERVE AVIATION INTERESTS IN THE MID-ATLANTIC REGION AT JOHN MURTHA JOHNSTOWN-CAMBRIA COUNTY AIRPORT (JST).

Located adjacent to a state highway connecting to multiple distribution routes and situated in the heart of the Laurel Highlands region, the Mid-Atlantic Opportunity Park is being developed by Cambrian Hills Development Group in partnership with the Cambria County Airport Authority. The development encompasses nearly 130 acres with direct runway access and is located:

- 65 nautical miles from Pittsburgh
- 121 nautical miles from Washington D.C.
- 168 nautical miles from Philadelphia
- 183 nautical miles from Richmond
- 232 nautical miles from New York
- 423 nautical miles from Chicago

The Mid-Atlantic Opportunity Park opens new potential not only to aviation interests but also to a region of more than 42 million and those who seek multimodal opportunities to meet their needs from a community with a growing economy, talented workforce, low cost of living, a quality public school system and a variety of colleges, universities and trade schools.

ANCHORED BY AN AVIATION MAGNET

Anchoring the Mid-Atlantic Opportunity Park will be a state-of-the-art, 100,000-square-foot Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO) facility capable of accommodating narrow-body airline and corporate aircraft. JST's 7,000-foot runways, FAA-operated air-traffic control tower and approach control radar already serving an adjacent Army National Guard base, de-ice capability of large aircraft, fueling services, and fire and emergency services on the field provides all the elements necessary for a new MRO and other aviation-related business to thrive.

Numerous aviation parks across the country that host MROs have become magnets for aviation industry suppliers, from avionics to parts depots, training facilities and more. With demand continuing to increase for maintenance, repair and operations providers, it has been estimated that 2020's \$616 billion value will have grown to \$701 billion by 2026, according to Mordor Intelligence.

The Mid-Atlantic Opportunity Park has been designated by the state of Pennsylvania as a Keystone State Opportunity Zone.

The communities making up the Laurel Highlands region of Western Pennsylvania offer an outstanding and affordable quality of life, still just an hour's drive from the metropolitan assets of Pittsburgh. In recent years, the region's economy has grown with significant health care, technology and finance expansion.

The Mid-Atlantic Opportunity Park Layout


